DTS, a leader in the construction industry specialising in surveying, town planning, and urban design, sought to modernise its IT infrastructure. The company faced flexibility challenges with on-premises equipment and needed to support a growing remote workforce. Aryon partnered with DTS to design a cloud migration strategy focused on flexibility and cost- efficiency.

- Adopt and optimise usage of Microsoft's cloud-based productivity suite.
- Minimise reliance on physical servers and limiting on-premises infrastructure..
- Enable seamless collaboration for a growing remote workforce

THE CHALLENGE

DTS faced the challenge of aging on-premises infrastructure, which limited their flexibility and increased ongoing costs. They needed a solution to support their growing remote workforce while reducing their on-premises IT footprint. The solution needed to scale in line with the business and, ideally, rationalise IT costs.
